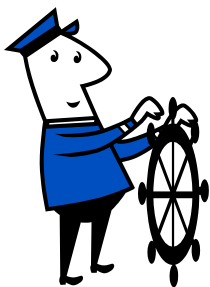


Manager's Corner

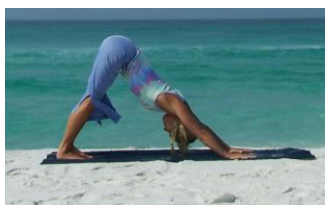

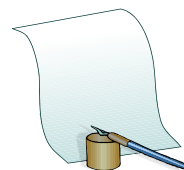
The Cahill Black Point
