As many of you are aware the boat launch needs significant repair to the slope and surface. A group met with the Department of Energy and Environmental Protection analyst to ensure the upcoming repairs will be consistent with state and federal regulations. A Request For Proposal (RFP) was submitted to various engineering firms. The responses will be evaluated by a selection committee that will bring a recommendation to the Board of Governors regarding the best way to proceed. 


