Proposed Regulation Changes to the following: Clarification of building height, building lines, and setbacks. General regulations on boats, camping trailers, or utility trailers. Inclusion of Soil and Erosion Control Regulations. Inclusion of Portable Storage Containers (PODS) Regulations.
