General Rules



"Swim and boating zones"

The tall buoys are markers for restricted areas. That means that all watercraft must stay

beyond the boundaries marked by them. The swim lines, aka geese lines, do not define the boundaries for boats; swimmers may be swimming beyond them.

All beaches are open to sunbathing and swimming with two exceptions. Those are the beaches south of Sea View, and north of Osprey. These are assigned by DEEP as boat launch beaches. For the safety of all, please refrain from swimming and sunbathing at them.

"Golf carts"

Golf carts can be driven only by licensed drivers. They must be registered. They may not be driven after sunset. In order to park in BPBCA parking lots and right of ways, they must display a parking tag.
