


Recreation Club Black Point 2019

Chair Corner

Dear Neighbors,

I'd like to update you on progress toward the pier reconstruction. You can also follow pier subcommittee news at <u>blackpointbeachclub.com</u>.

The BOG and Pier Committee met on July 17th to review the contract with *GNBC*, *Docko and* Pinder Construction Company for the pier reconstruction. Our attorney had already made some changes with the agreement of Pinder's lawyer. At the meeting the board and committee requested a few minor modifications to the contract; it is not expected that these will present any obstacles. Once they are agreed upon, the contract will be signed.

Meanwhile, DEEP applications have been signed and submitted to DEEP on the 15th. Approval may take up to 90 days. While waiting for DEEP approval, Pinder will be ordering the steel which has to be epoxy coated for our use.

Once the contract is signed, we will begin a schedule of payments for design engineering, which is provided by GNCB Consulting Engineers and Docko, who are contracted by Pinder, and, if our changes to the contract are accepted, we will pay for the steel as soon as it is delivered to Pinder and inspected by us. No further construction costs will be paid until work begins, and payments will be made as stages of work are completed. The pier committee will be selecting an engineer to oversee the project on behalf of BPBCA once the DEEP applications have been approved.

Pending approval by DEEP, it is anticipated that work will begin after Labor Day, at which point main beach will be closed until project completion. The project is expected to be completed in December, barring extraordinary weather circumstances.

Once the contract has been signed, a copy will be placed in the club house for those who would like to read it. This reconstruction is a significant part of Black Point's history and will contribute to our future enjoyment of our beaches. I appreciate that this expense has presented difficulties for some and I thank you for your sacrifices. I would like to thank Steve Beauchene and the members of the pier subcommittee, John Campion, Will Fountain, Ron Gianamore, Mike Johnson, Bob Kallagher, Phil Lombardo, and Jim Moffettf for offering expertise, research, and hours of time toward bringing this project to fruition.

Enjoy these summer days, get into the water as much as possible, and remember that it is a good 10 degrees cooler at the shore than it is inland. We are so fortunate!
