Public Comments:

- Will East Lyme electors (non-property owners) be eligible to vote, in addition to the trust, under the proposed charter revisions? Anita Schepker said no.
- What happens if a property owner owns more than one property (different addresses)? Anita Schepker answered that it would depend on how the properties were organized.

Committee reviewed the proposed changes. Relevant issues:

- > The typographical errors will be corrected and noted.
- > Substantive changes will be addressed such as "land" has been changed to "property"
- Recommend that the Board of Governors decide if and how to address "member representative" and do so via a bylaws change, rather than including it in the charter.
- > Ask the Board of Governors to add the Charter Revision to the July 22<sup>nd</sup> meeting agenda.
- > Review when the public hearing must be held
- Ask that a meeting for the members to vote upon the Charter Revision be held on Labor Day weekend.
- If the members approve, we will move forward with having this introduced for the 2022 Legislative Session.
