Wrecking Crew Landscaping Group is seeking Volunteers

The BPBCA Wrecking Crew is seeking volunteers for the newly formed Landscaping group to address the Landscaping (Flowers and Plants), or lack of same on Associations property in Black Point.

The Wrecking Crew Landscaping group has so far this year accomplished the following, with almost everything (including seven 7 pots and most of the perennials and annuals) having been donated.

- Cleaned up Whitecap parking lot including removing leaves, trimming shrubs and perimeter overgrowth, weeding, and edging the garden with rocks, sanding and painting the posts, planting two butterfly bushes and 2 planters with marigolds.
- Removed weds to expose rocks to the right of shuffleboard at the Clubhouse creating a perennial and annual rock garden.
- Painted the posts and back of the Clubhouse sign.
- Cleaning the gardens at both Black Point signs and in front of the Clubhouse.
- Planting perennials at the Woodland Street entrance to Black Point.
- Constructing and installing five (5) planters for use in beach access areas.

The Wrecking Crew Landscaping group is also currently exploring the possibility of establishing and maintaining a community garden and community compost bin next fall.
