

Reminder of a Few General BP Rules

- "Parking tags are still required on cars and golf carts.
- Golf carts must be registered and driven by a licensed driver only, by state law. They may not be driven after sundown

Kayaks must have a BP registration sticker to use any kayak rack. They can be gotten at no cost from Will Fountain email, mrwill34@gmail.com or text 203-815-6757. If not on the racks, registered kayaks on the beach can be identified in case of emergency. There are now two racks on the Sea Spray ROW. Please do not trespass on neighboring property or seawalls when launching your kayak from the ROW.
