A Wrecking Crew work party is assisting with the marking of wetlands on Association property.

A Wrecking Crew work party is doing minor repairs to the Ga Ga pit.

A Wrecking Crew work party is making repairs to the Association large round tables.

A Wrecking Crew work party is currently working to evaluate the present configuration of the BPBCA Beach Swim Areas / Swim Floats and make recommendations to the BOG for improvements to better utilize these resources.

A Wrecking Crew work-party is performing site work in preparation for the Volleyball Court which will be installed behind the Clubhouse.

A Wrecking Crew work-party continues to clear and removed brush, debris, and leaves from the perimeter of the Play-Ground area behind the Club House.

A Wrecking Crew work-party is in the process of removing brush, debris, and leaves from areas around the Clay Tennis Courts.

A Wrecking Crew work party has examined, and will continue to monitor, reporting to the BOG, the condition of all Associations piers, making any emergency repairs (within the capabilities of the Wrecking Crew) when deemed necessary.

A Wrecking Crew work party has contacted the Niantic River Watershed Committee regarding having storm drain catch basins marked "Drains to the Bay". Hopefully this will remind the dog people that throwing plastic bags of dog excrement into our storm drains goes directly onto our beaches and then into Niantic Bay.

The Wrecking Crew Landscaping group has been watering (with Jim Moffett's assistance) and maintaining (weeding and dead heading) all the areas that they have been working on so far this year.

The Wrecking Crew Landscaping group has submitted an estimate to the BPBCA BOG for materials that will be necessary to build and maintain the community garden, which may also include a compost bin and rain barrel.
