Yoga begins at 7:00a.m. at the Clubhouse on Monday, Wednesday and Friday. \$5.00 per class. Remember




classes will continue into part of September. Beginners are always welcome! Hope to see you there and don't forget to bring your Yoga mat and water bottle.
