

**Special acts and resolutions of the General Assembly of the state of Connecticut. v.28
(v.XXVIII) 1957**

**AN ACT AMENDING THE CHARTER OF THE BLACK POINT BEACH CLUB ASSOCIATION,
CONCERNING ITS BORROWING POWER.**

Section 2 of number 20 of the special acts of 1947 is repealed and the following is substituted in lieu thereof: The governing board shall have the right to borrow not more than fifty thousand dollars in anticipation of taxes and for public improvements, when authorized by a majority vote of the members present at any regular or special meeting, duly warned.

Approved May 2, 1957.

(note: this borrowing power was subsequently leveraged for the construction of the Sea Breeze pier and the Boat Ramp at Sea View)
