

APPLICATION FOR BPBA BOARD OF GOVERNORS'

PERMISSION TO USE RIGHTS-OF-WAY OR WHITECAP PARKING LOT FOR STAGING

The applicant understands and agrees that by being granted permission to use BPBA's property is conditional on returning all properties to equal or improved condition when use is terminated. It is understood that the rights-of-way are the property of BPBA and the responsibility of the Board of Governors to protect. Photographs of the areas to be used will be taken by the applicant and submitted with this request in order that there is no confusion regarding the initial condition of the area involved. Failure to return to original or better condition will result in a delayed Certificate of Occupancy from BPBA Zoning Enforcement Officer until reparations have been satisfactorily addressed. If the weather does not allow full restoration of the area, a cash bond for the full restoration shall be in place for a final Certificate of Occupancy to be issued. The bond will be returned upon full restoration to the satisfaction of the Zoning Enforcement Officer. Erosion control methods must be used to prevent drainage into the roadway, storm drains, or adjacent property.
